内容提要：本书内容介绍，你想知道人类最早的法律是如何诞生的吗？请看这部《圣经故事—摩西十诫》。圣经的文字比较刻板，难以阅读。菲律宾华人作家庄子明用时下盛行的小说笔法，完成了这部既引人入胜又富于哲理的经典名著，不但讴歌了百万以色列奴隶摆脱奴役奔向理想境地的壮举，而且痛切地揭示了自由了的人民在没有法律的情况下如何纵欲寻欢、道德沦丧、罪恶泛滥；不但刻划了先是王子后是牧羊人的摩西超人的大智大勇，并且展示了既是神的仆人又是奴隶领袖的摩西凡人的复杂情感，使人读来柔肠寸断、感慨万端，对今天的青年人了解法律也有着很好的借鉴作用。

Summary:

How does the earliest law of humankind come into existence? This book is to answer this question. The words of the Bible are rather dull, and difficult to read. The author, a Filipino Chinese writer, employs the narrative rhetoric in current to complete this classics which is fascinating and deep in thoughts. It not only eulogises the great deed in liberating millions of Israelites from bondage towards the Land of Promise, but also painfully reveals how the liberated people, under the absence of law, indulged themselves in desires and pleasure, in moral decaying, and in sins. It not only portrays the great wisdom and courage of Moses who was at first a prince and later on as a shepherd, but also reveals the complex sentiments of the man Moses who is both the servant of God and the leader of the slaves. It makes the readers full of sentiments and emotions, and it is also good in introducing the youth in the present time to the concept of law. There are twelve stories in this book: (1) Divine Presence in Mount Sinai ; (2) The Golden Calf; (3) The God-Man Encounter by the Burning Bushes; (4) The Great Mission of Moses; (5) The Stirred Up Situations; (6) The Competition of Miracles before Pharaoh; (7) The Ten Plagues; (8) Perishment; (9) The Exodus of the Israelites; (10) Forty Years in the Wilderness; (11) The Crossing of the Red Sea; (12) The Commandments Last Forever.
