Author's Profile	Evans is Professor of Medieval Theology and Intellectual History at the University of Cambridge and was British Academy Research Reader in Theology from 1986 to 1988. She has written on a wide range of medieval authors including Augustine, Gregory the Great, Anselm, Bernard of Clairvaux and Alan of Lille. She has also written <i>The Language and Logic of the Bible in the Middle Ages</i> (Cambridge University Press) and <i>Faith in the Medieval World</i> (IVP).
Abstract	Rocked by political, social, and economic change, the Middle Ages was culturally unified by a Christian worldview. Evans explores this stabilizing force by examining key aspects of medieval faith: Bible study, popular piety, the concept of "holy war," politics and the church, religious rebellion, and the road to Reformation.
