7. 内容提要：本书作者认为，过程神学是一种哲学神学，是一场深受过程哲学思想影响的神学运动。本书涉及教义信仰、人的存在、自然神学、生存神学、妇女解放、全球危机等许多重要问题。通过本书，可以了解西方现代神学的发展及观点，了解西方学者对人类面临的多种重大问题的回应和对策。本书共计 9 章：第 1 章为通过哲学的基本概念(过程、享受、本质的联系、道成肉身、创造性的自决、创造性的自我表达、新质、上帝—关联性)；第 2 章为教义信仰和基督教存生(教义和前主题化的经验、教义之有选择的重点、前反映的经验和信仰之根、教义和历史)；第 3 章为作为创造—回应之爱的上帝(上帝的存在、作为回应之爱的上帝、作为创造之爱的上帝、作为说服性的神的创造之爱、作为增进享受的神的创造之爱、作为历险的神的创造之爱、作为创造—回应之爱的上帝)；第 4 章为自然神学(进化过程的原因是什么？世界上为什么有这么多恶？生态学的态度如何可能？)；第 5 章为人类存在(过程神学和存在人类学、人类存在的结构)；第 6 章为耶稣基督(怀特海论耶稣和道成肉身、作为创造性改造的基督、基督和耶稣、作为基督肉身的教会、三一体)；第 7 章为末世论(历史的未来、天国、和平)；第 8 章为创造改造中的教会(基督和教会、教会和妇女解放、教会和佛教)；第 9

章为全球危机与生存神学 (时空规模、人类和自然、生态学的感受性、责任和希望)

He has authored *Process Theology as Political Theology*, *The Liberation of Life: from Cell to Community* (co-authored), and *Process Philosophy and Social Thoughts* (co-edited).
David R. Griffin is Professor of Philosophy of Religion, Claremont Theological Seminary and Claremont Graduate School, director of Postmodern Research Center in St. Barbara, and the Executive Director of the Research Center for Process Theology. He has authored *God, Power, and Sin*, and edited *Postmodern Science: the Resurgence of the Scientific Enchantment*, *The Postmodern Ethos*, *The Ultimate Meaning of Physics and Time*, etc.
6. Précis: The authors believe that process theology is a philosophical theology deeply influenced by process philosophy. The book touches on doctrinal beliefs, human existence, natural theology, existential theology, feminism, global crises, etc. It gives us an understanding of the development and perspectives of modern Western theology, and how Western scholars respond to the big issues facing humanity.
